

The 2012 Chippewa Swim Program



What is the Chippewa Swim Program?

The Chippewa Swim Program is a chance for your scouts to earn the Swimming or Lifesaving Merit Badges. Merit Badge counselors will be at the pool to pass scout on the Merit Badge Requirements

Who: Boy Scout ready to earn the Swimming and Lifesaving Merit Badges

When: March 9, 16, 23

Where: Cousino High School - (30333 Hoover Rd Warren MI 48093)

Cost: \$16.00 for each scout

Important things to remember about registration:

- You must pre-register. No walk-ins will be allowed.
- You must register the scouts name and the badge he is taking. Scouts will only be able to take one merit badge.
- Make all registrations through your Troop, No money can be collected at the pool
- There will be 60 Swimming and 25 Lifesaving spots. Once the spaces are full no more registrations can be taken.
- Registration is on a first come first serve policy and will start on January 18 and go until all the spots are full.



This is not an instructional course, all participants must be able to swim and do the requirements for the badge they are taking. Scouts should practice the Merit Badge requirement prior to attending the Swim Program to ensure that the scout can pass the requirements.

Important information To Remember

- * The Swim Program will start promptly at 7:00pm (arrive at 6:30 to change) and end approx. 9:30pm
- * Scouts must attend all 3 weeks in order to complete the merit badge.
- * Scouts are not guaranteed to earn the merit badge at this event.
- * Knowledge of CPR is required for merit badges.
- * *All scouts must have a signed and **completely filled out** blue card on the 1st night (March 9).*

How do I register my scout? All registrations are handled by your Troop, we do not accept individual registrations and all participants must be preregistered.
