## General Information

- 1: The Unit Award of Appreciation is presented by districts.
- 2: The award is available to adult volunteers who render service of an outstanding nature at the unit level.
- 3: The award is made available on the basis of one (1) for each unit.
- 4: It is not appropriate to nominate an adult volunteer who has already received this award.

## Requirements

- 1: A nominee may or may not be a registered Scouter.
- 2: A nominee should have rendered noteworthy unit service to the unit.  
**Note:** The nature and value of "noteworthy service" may consist of a single plan or decisions that contribute to the unit.
- 3: Nominations should not be considered for posthumous awards.

### **Procedure:**

- 1: Forms to be turned in to the District Awards committee through District Professional or Unit Commissioner.

- 2: The following procedure is suggested for such presentation ceremonies:
  - a: The recipient and spouse should be in attendance at the annual recognition dinner.
  - b: A district officer will explain the award and it's significance.
  - c: A certificate suitable for framing will be awarded to each recipient.
  - d: Certificates will be presented at the Chippewa District dinner. If the recipient is not in attendance, the certificate will be provided to the unit for presenting at an appropriate time of the units choosing.

**3: Once this form is turned in, the award is final. This is not an approval process award. It is up to the Unit to make sure the award recipient is there and tickets for the dinner are purchased.**
